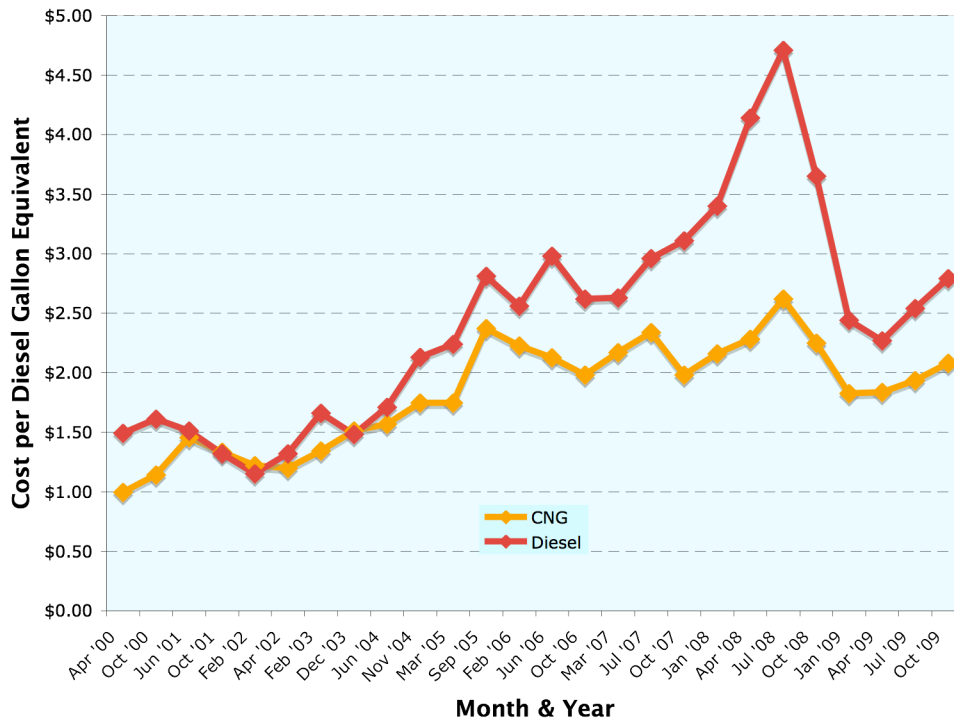

U.S. Prices of Compressed Natural Gas and Diesel Fuel, 2000-2009

The graph below traces fuel prices of compressed natural gas (CNG) and diesel, based on “average” prices for the U.S. as a whole. The CNG price shown represents the price per “diesel gallon equivalent.” Typically natural gas fuel costs less than diesel and is less volatile in price.
